The members of the board of directors and each officer of the association have a fiduciary relationship with the members of the association.

This fiduciary relationship imposes obligations of trust and confidence in favor of the corporation and its members. It requires the members of the board to act in good faith and in the best interests of the members of the association. It means that board members must exercise due care and diligence when acting for the community.

The fact that the association is a not-for-profit corporation, or that the members of the board are volunteers and unpaid, does not relieve them from the high standards of trust and responsibility that the fiduciary relationship requires.

So, the next time you see them out and about in the community enjoying their personal time, a simple "thank you" for their service would go a long way. At the same time please do not take the liberty of imposing on their personal time with an issue you may have.
