MANAGER'S MESSAGE

Still Gettin R Done!

The HVAC unit at Clubhouse has been replaced as well as Craft Room transition from swamp cooled to air conditioning is complete. Replacement of Woodshop and Clubhouse Roofs are scheduled for mid-June. The Artificial Turf to be installed end of June at west side of Clubhouse and Putting Green to Classroom, and the (2) new recumbent bikes for the Fitness Center are in.

Physical Properties is removing all of the ceiling tiles in entire Clubhouse and Craft Building in preparation of the Electrical Contractor on site week of June 3rd to begin transition to LED Lighting, which will include exterior lights on both buildings as well. We will also include some upgrades to the lighting control system in the Ballroom and Social Hall at that same time. When that work is complete we will then have the floors refinished, followed by the installation of Acoustic Sound Panels in both Ballroom and Social Hall.

Bids on the Tennis Deck project are due May 31st, they will be forwarded to the Tennis Enhancement Committee for review and recommendation of which contractor to be awarded project, and then presented to the BOD for final approval. The Tennis Club has committed \$50,000.00 from their treasury for this project. Once contractor in place we will get scheduled start and completion dates to assure it's ready to go before season start-up.

The Pool/Hot tub cool deck seal repair project will be presented to the BOD at their June 19th, 2019 meeting. We will notify residents of the pool closing date as soon as scheduled. As always, Fountain of the Sun has agreed to allow CM residents use of their pool while ours is unavailable. We have nice neighbors.

All of these projects happening in the time span of three to four months, with many contractors in the resort for each project, reminds me to thank all of the year-round residents for their patience while being inconvenienced, especially this summer.

The final draft of the 2018 Audit has been presented to the Budget and Finance committee for review, and will also be on the BOD's June meeting agenda. I want to thank our Finance Administrator Linda Jean Robinson for the stellar report we received as well as the B&F members for their review of the audited financial records.

Now that the audit is complete we begin developing the 2020 budget and continue to research website developers to update our current website and allow for a more user friendly experience. The BOD also approved OnPoint Architecture to work with the Patriot's Park sub-committee of Long Range Planning to develop site plan of the conceptual drawing they brought forward to the BOD. Please remember, your Governing Documents require a vote of the membership prior to Common Area Development per By-Law 12 .1.

I have commitments from both Jerry Combs and John Murray to return this fall. The Patio Grill will be open for breakfast and lunch first week of November with menu items and Daily Specials that have proven track records of success.

This variance will allow for those slide outs providing they *do not extend* onto the next property and there *cannot* be a permanent type structure in the easements **OR** Moss/Overland (Distributor for Park Models & MFG Homes) has looked at this lot and can design a Park Model that will work with that AZ room intact!

#508, one of the newest and gorgeous Manufactured home currently For Sale. This one is a 2016, 18' wide, hardy board siding, beautiful flooring, granite countertops throughout, all appliances are full size stainless, an awesome stainless farm sink and even a smaller beverage fridge.
