We in the security department have just completed our first complete walk around of each and every residence in the resort. I am very pleased to announce that we only had five issues with doors left unsecure. This is the best we have witnessed ever since I have been at Carriage Manor. We called each resident that had an issue and compiled an incident report for each of our findings.

During our walk arounds of every home we also ensure that all screen doors have been secured and in the full closed position. As we drive around during our patrols, if we identify a screen door in the open position, we stop and complete an entire walk around the home to ensure that nothing has been disturbed and then secure the door.

We also compiled a list of each resident with a bicycle in the driveways and/or the deck areas. Security then took photos of each residence with bicycles and placed them on a CD to be in retention at the security office. This is to have a reference point when doing our normal inspections of the resort. Again, I would like each resident that does own a bicycle to purchase a lock and lock them up.

14 Under Contract/Pending Listings in Carriage Manor

- 11 Park Models priced between \$100,000 \$210,000
- 3 Park Models between \$79,000 \$99,900

42 Closed Sales (January 1 - May 26, 2021)

- 4 RV or vacant lots Sold between \$68,000 \$86,000
- 4 homes without AZ Rooms Sold between \$77,500 \$99,900
- 34 homes with AZ Rooms Sold between \$80,000 \$170,000

The highest price homes, newer or remodeled with Arizona Rooms, are selling quickly. The older, lower priced homes are currently taking longer to sell BUT I think we'll be seeing these start to move also now that our inventory is so low. Now, being a 55+ community we aren't experiencing the same gains as other areas of the real estate market, but our inventory of homes is now back to pre-covid levels.


