## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

One of the biggest challenges that we face as your board of directors is communicating with our residents. Communication is a two-way street. The board frequently needs to get relevant information out to our residents. But more importantly we often need your inputs to help in many of the decisions that the board is called upon to make.

We have several ways to communicate with our residents:

1) Wednesday coffee - this is normally a one-way communication with a time limit so not much info can be shared. And by definition is a weekly event. And will only reach those in attendance.

2) Open forums - dedicated to one or two subjects. Requires advance notice using one of the remaining methods. And will only reach those in attendance. I think this proved especially effective during our last open forum dealing with our decision regarding Broadband Holdings.

3) Board meetings and workshops - much more structured and does not easily allow questions and answers. And will only reach those in attendance

4) Manor News TV in the social hall - no interaction at all with the residents, just a news feed. And reaches an even smaller audience because of the low attendance to the patio grill

5) Email blasts to all residents - Totally a one-way communication with very limited space to include a full presentation of information or ideas. But does reach the widest audience of residents

6) Rumble Sheet - Reaches a wide audience but is limited by the monthly publication schedule. Deadline is the 10th of each month for the following month and requires advance planning for all articles. And again, this does not allow any interaction with our audience.

7) Comment form - this is a good way to get ideas/questions/comments to the general manager as well as the BOD. It serves to document a communication for future reference.

8) Private email - Occasionally the general manager or some of the directors will receive emails from our residents with specific questions or concerns.

And a final comment regarding anonymous feedback. This is the most difficult type of feedback to deal with. It's hard to verify facts, it's hard to answer questions because we don't know who to direct the answer to. And please remember, our primary goal is always to reach a decision that is best for all of Carriage Manor.

## CARRIAGE MANOR REALTY CORNER

This month I wanted to give you an idea about things you should consider when you are ready to list and sell your home. No matter the age of your Park Model or Manufactured Home, it is the same. LESS is BEST!

Decluttering shelves, cabinet tops, tables, etc. is a great way to start. Put away as many personal items as you can so the Buyer will know what is and is not included in the sale. You may have a favorite painting on the wall that you plan on taking but the Buyer may also think it is fabulous and be upset when it's not there when they move in. Having less "things" on shelves and countertops will also give the feel of more openness, which is desirable. If your blinds are broken or missing slats, those can be easily replaced to give it a better look. Some furniture may be leaving with you? Can you store it somewhere out of the Park Model? Again, then there is no confusion on what stays.

Did you know that once your place is under contract the Title Company will request HOA information from Carriage Manor Resort. Carriage

Manor forwards that request to the HOA Architectural Review Committee (ARC), who in turn does an external inspection of your Park Model to ensure it follows the HOA rules & regulations for the new owner. Some of the items the HOA person might inspect are your trees. They need to be trimmed to be within your property lines, and not in someone else's yard or the street. The skirting needs to be in good condition, no dented or missing pieces. Carpet on the steps has been a concern in the past. Satellite dishes improperly mounted. Temporary structures such as storage sheds, are they sitting in the designated 5-7 foot setbacks? The ARC reports any violations on their inspection form, which then gets shared with the buyer.

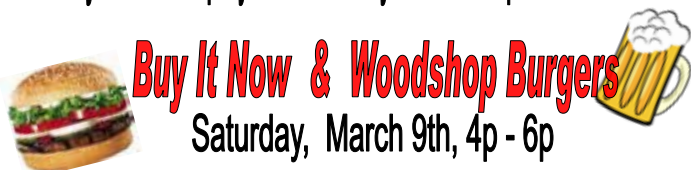

# Water Cents

Even though Carriage Manor residents don't receive a bill for their water usage, that does not mean we don't pay for it. Our monthly HOA fee not only includes the shared cost of the water used, but also a cost for sewage disposal based on the same number of gallons.

In an effort to limit HOA fee increases, and recognizing the long-term negative impact of the continuing drought on water supplies, your Board of Directors has tasked the Long Range Planning Committee with addressing the management and conservation of not only water, but power and solid waste as well. Cost-saving actions are underway concerning recycling and electrical upgrades, so we are now turning our attention to "the elephant in the room", our water usage.

According to the EPA, "toilets are by far the main source of water usage in the home, accounting for nearly 30% of an average home's indoor water consumption". We believe that figure is probably higher in Carriage Manor due to the age of most units. We have estimated that if all our toilets were upgraded to modern *WaterSense* labeled units and leaking toilets were repaired, we could save approximately one-third of our in-home water cost.

To this end, the Resource Management & Conservation subcommittee is initiating an ongoing CM community water

conservation and education program. Informative literature about toilets, toilet leak testing and water conservation, as well as free leak-test dye kits can be picked-up at the Front Desk. By upgrading or repairing our toilets and adjusting our flushing habits, significant cost reduction is possible!

To encourage CM residents to upgrade to *WaterSense* compliant toilets, a \$25 cash rebate is available for each toilet replaced. Applications and details are available at the Front Desk.
