

DID YOU KNOW? Do you know about the R-22 Phaseout?

Starting January 2020, it will be illegal to produce or import the refrigerant R-22 in the U.S. Although no new R-22 can be produced or imported, there will still be an existing supply that can be used for older AC systems. Air conditioning systems manufactured before 2010 likely use \$-22 refrigerant. Those systems made after 2010, however, use a new more environmentally-friendly type of refrigerant, called R-410z (also known by the trade name "Puron"). The R-22 phaseout will not affect these newer AC systems using R-410a. The older systems, remaining or recycled/reclaimed R-22 can still be used for service. There are also now many EPA-approved alternatives to R-22. So, starting in 2020, if an AC system has a leak and needs refrigerant, the technician can still add R-22 refrigerant or replace it with an appropriate alternative. If the AC system needs more extensive repairs or new components that only work with newer refrigerants, it may need to be retrofitted to use a new refrigerant or replaced entirely. Any questions about your HVAC (AC) systems should be directed to a competent and qualified HVAC contractor as to the future serviceability and projected longevity of the unit.

However, as I've learned more and more about this issue it has become apparent that we simply will not be able to handle this in the Patio Grill.

For those who have celiac disease it is crucial that if they eat something called "gluten free" that it really is. I have learned recently that any cross contamination with gluten products could cause huge problems.

When we work with a large volunteer base it is impossible to request a separate area be used to prepare a gluten free meal, not being able to run bread through the toaster where it comes in contact with bread containing gluten. It's just too monumental of a task for us to tackle.

So, for the health and safety of those who cannot handle any gluten we will no longer offer any gluten free items. It would have been nice to accommodate this population, but it's not worth the potential risk to their health to proclaim that we can provide a gluten free meal.



RECYCLING & CONSERVATION

If you are finding the "new" recycling instructions from the City of Mesa confusing, you are not alone. Not only have the items that are acceptable for recycling changed from our program last spring, the labels on the recycling bins have not been updated to keep up with the changes. Many items that we have traditionally recycled here at Carriage Manor, and likely at your other homes as well, are no longer accepted. So, what's going on with recycling? The recycling world has dramatically changed. While recycling still provides environmental benefits, several markets are no longer accepting material from the United States. Some materials currently have such low demand that the volatility of their market value is jeopardizing the financial stability of recycling programs across the country, including Mesa.

To help you properly recycle, we have placed an up-to-date list of items that are no longer accepted on the front of the bins. These items should now be put in the big roll-off dumpster in the maintenance area or placed in bags in front of your residence on your regular trash pickup day, but not on Wednesday, which is recycle pickup day. Also, please remember that kitchen trash (food scraps, coffee grounds, egg shells, vegetable waste, food trays, paper and plastic bags, plates, napkins, towels, unwashed food containers or anything else with food residue on it) goes into the compactor, also in the maintenance area, or at the curb on trash pickup day. Please note that the bins labeled CARDBOARD ONLY are for *corrugated cardboard only*, nothing else. Please recycle responsibly. Thank you for caring.

Water conservation is still a priority for cost savings in Carriage Manor, as well as good stewardship of this precious resource. To encourage residents to repair or replace older toilets, leak test dye tablets are available in the activity office. If a toilet is replaced with a WaterSense-labeled unit, a \$25 cash rebate is available. Please obtain a form at the front desk and follow the instructions for submitting. Thank you.
