

- 3) No plastic bags ever! Dump the shredded paper and take the bag home.

Hello to everyone! I would like to take the opportunity to go over a few Arizona laws that must be complied with. To include bicycles, golf carts, and any motorized type of vehicle subject to follow the same rules of the road as an automobile, staying on the proper side of the road, stopping at all stop signs, watching for the pedestrians crossing the roadways and so on. Remember that pedestrians always have the right of way.

We all need to come to a complete stop at all stop signs. We cannot just roll through them. We have witnessed several times folks not coming to a complete stop and have came very close on different occasions, people getting struck coming from E. Desoto across the back side of the office and can't be seen until they are almost in front of the stop sign from the on coming traffic. Security office approaching area, and the departing area, as well the contractor/visitors side, we need to come to a complete stop at the stop signs.

**SPEED LIMIT!** we all are aware, that the speed limit is 10 MPH within the confines of the Carriage manor Resort.

One final note. The security staff has completed the resort wide collection of the bicycle's and have placed the photos in a file in the security office for the year of 2022. We have also started the house-to-house checks making certain that all doors and windows are secured. You can even call a few days before if you're not exactly sure which day they will arrive. You can authorize them for a certain timeframe.

### Everything you wanted to know about The Third-Party Agreement but

### were afraid to ask

This article will provide information for those owners who may be first time renters but also has good reminders for those who have been renting for some time.

### What is a third-party agreement?

This is a form required by owners of a unit who are renting it to another. It will show the names and contact information of the owner and renter of a unit. It can be obtained at the Front Desk or online.

### What's the purpose of this document?

To ensure the all the requirements are met. At least one member of the rental party must be over 55 and the younger member must be over 40. Only two people are allowed to occupy the unit for a stay of not less than 28 days. There may be variances granted by the Board of Director.

If it is a renter with an RV, it assures that the vehicle is not over 10 years old, over 26' and less than 40'. Exceptions to these requirements may be made with an ARC variance.

### What if I need to have a variance?

If a variance is required either from ARC for the RV or from the Board of Directors for other cases, this should be done well in advance as they meet once a month to vote on the approval. These forms are available at the Front Desk and online.

### What needs to be provided with the form?

The owner needs to pay a \$25 processing fee and to submit this form one week prior to the beginning of the rental period. It is very disruptive if there is no form on file when the renters are checking in. It creates a great deal of confusion and doesn't make for a good first impression of Carriage Manor.

The renter will need to provide the license plate number and show their driver's license as proof of their age. They will be charged \$10 each for a name badge to be worn during their stay. They will be given the option to pay \$15 for a gate pass to be applied to their vehicle.

### But I'm letting my family member stay in the unit and not charging any rent, do I still need to do this?

Yes. It is important that we know who is living in the resort and have the emergency contact information for them.

### How often is this needed?

This is required for each rental period. If you have a new renter each month you would have 12 Third-Party Agreements. It is required annually if you have a long-term renter or are allowing a family member to live in the unit without rent. This is to keep the information current in case of an emergency.

### What if I'm having a family member visit me for a week?

They would be considered a "guest" and are subject to the 14 days per calendar year limit with no carryover. However, a form is still required so we know who is in the unit and from what dates. There is no charge for this Third-Party Agreement, it is purely to obtain emergency information. The guests will be required to obtain a name badge.

I hope this article has been helpful and has answered some questions you may have had.
