
## TEXAS HOLD-EM TUESDAY EVENING TOURNAMENT

The POKER ROOM is located on the South side of the Club House by the putting greens.



## The Patio Grill Saga

In the October issue of the Rumble Sheet you read the article entitled "The Last Chance Café" which outlined all the changes that were going to happen to the Patio Grill to allow it to continue. It was a really good plan...right up until about a week prior to our proposed opening of November 1st. Then our committee ran into the issue of not having enough bodies to run the kitchen.

Several have commented how volunteerism has declined over the years and it really hit home this year.

So, we are making an all out appeal for volunteers for the Patio Grill which is tentatively planned to open the first Monday in January 2022. Training is available for anyone new, don't feel like you're being thrown to the wolves and left on your own.

There are several positions open to consider. We need cashiers to take the orders and handle the money.

All positions in the kitchen require having a food handlers license, which can be obtained by taking an online course and paying a small fee. The kitchen positions are either a cook or a server. You must abide by all requirements of Maricopa County, which you will learn in your food handlers course.

The cook is responsible for working the grill to fill orders coming in.

The servers get the meal ticket from the cashier to the cook, assist in prepping meals, making toast, dishing up the specials from the warming trays and plating food coming off the grill. The name is called out through the window and the customers comes to pick up their food. On occasion you will be expected to deliver the food if the person has mobility issues and as time allows.

It can be a lot of fun and you receive a free meal at the end of your shift as a reward for your volunteer service.

All you need to do is visit the front desk or the Activity Office and ask for a volunteer form. You may find other places that you might enjoy volunteering as well.


