I notice visitors and residents as they approach the entrance arms, they wait for the arm to rise as they go through. There is a stop sign on each side of the roadway. SECURITY **WILL NOT** LET UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS ON TO YOUR PROPERTY. THIS INCLUDES CONTRACTORS. IF YOU DO NOT CALL SECURITY AND AUTHORIZE DIRECTLY, CONTRACTORS MAY BE BARRED FROM ENTRANCE.

You can even call a few days before if you're not exactly sure which day they will arrive.

You can authorize them for a certain timeframe.

Agreements must be received least 1 week prior to your renter arriving, I'd prefer earlier if possible. 
- 1. Make sure your renters are aware they need to check in at the front desk. We will ask them to show ID to establish proof of age and pay a \$10 per person resort fee.
- 2. At check in we will provide them with a gate pass, name badges and information on Carriage Manor, to make them feel welcome. Please advise your renter they will receive a blue gate pass for their vehicle when they check in with the front desk, but if they would like easier access, they may purchase a gate decal for \$15.
- 3. Be aware neither the Admin Office nor Security will hold keys for your renter.


