PRESIDENT'S PAGE

Happy New Year! Here's hoping that we all have a great upcoming year in spite of the current

pandemic. We, your board of directors, as well as our admin staff have been getting a lot of questions and comments from residents who are concerned that we are not doing enough in the areas of communication about covid infections here in our resort. It is important to understand that we can only recommend guidelines that are consistent with guidelines set forth by Federal, State, and local governments as well as the Center for Disease Control (CDC). And you should also be aware that there is nothing in our governing documents giving us any authority or power to enforce these guidelines. It is up to each individual to recognize the need to follow these guidelines for their own safety as well as others that we come in contact with. We only have one tool in our toolbag and that is to limit access to our common areas when we determine that these guidelines are being ignored. This is not a decision to be taken lightly. It would extremely unfair to those who do follow our guidelines and then loose access to our common areas due the inconsideration of others.

We have also received several comments concerning notifications about new infections within the resort. Carriage Manor has never been officially notified about any covid infection in the resort. We hear about it the same way that you all do, either through rumors, or though a personal notification from a private party. If that person declines to have their name made public that we are legally bound by HIPAA privacy rules from disclosing any information without their consent.

As many of you may know, we have recently changed our Covid guidelines for new or returning residents. The previous guideline was a 14 day quarantine. Our new guideline is to either quarantine for 10 days, or quarantine for 7 days and then have a negative covid test.

Hello everyone! I hope everyone enjoyed the holiday season, I sure

did. And it's nice to see all the familiar faces bustling around the resort, taking in all the different activities. The new exercise room sure is being enjoyed by a lot of the residents, which is very nice to see so many people utilizing all the new exercise equipment, although there have been some changes to protect all residents.

The Security department unfortunately has witnessed an increase of the roadway infractions i.e., not coming to a complete stop, not complying to speed limit and so on. The resident's have formed a traffic safety committee, in which we are anticipating good things to come from the safety committee folks.

Once again, I have to speak in reference to the cameras and the associated hardware that makes everything work properly. In mid-September we added a couple of cameras to control Broadway road. The point is that the crime rate in this area exploded and the added cameras made a tremendous difference for the Carriage Manor Resort to watch over all perimeters of the resort.



Recycling, Trash and Water Conservation

If you have just returned to Carriage Manor for the season, you may have noticed the absence of the green recycling bins. Valley cities, like communities nationwide, are not recycling as they used to for several reasons. China, traditionally our largest market for recyclables, has tightened contamination standards, processors increased fees and recyclables dropped in value as the quantity of recycled materials increased. We went from being paid for our recyclables to just having them hauled away to, finally, having to pay to get them hauled away and learning that they were ending up in the landfill. As this situation evolved, we reached a point where it cost less to simply put all our trash into the big roll-off dumpster and eliminate the recycling bins. The City of Mesa is working with ASU to research several possible long-term solutions for recycling, but for now there is no longer a pick up program. Note that Carriage Manor no longer has curb-side recycling pick up on Wednesdays as a result. Also note that the Tennis Club is still recycling aluminum beverage cans as a fund-raiser. Their blue plastic barrels are still being used for collection.

Now for some serious trash talk. As you can guess, the cost of disposal of our trash placed into the big dumpster continues to increase. Each time it is emptied there is a basic tipping fee of about \$400 to which is added a surcharge based on the weight of the contents. To get "the most bang for our buck", it is important to minimize the wasted space that occurs when things like boxes and milk jugs are deposited without first flattening them. Let's not pay to dispose of air! Finally, we still have the kitchen garbage compactor. Bags placed in here should consist primarily of food prep and table scraps, including things like foam meat trays with absorbed juices.

Water; life cannot exist without it! With an extended Southwest drought and constantly booming Valley population, the cost of this resource has increased more than anticipated. The City of Mesa surprised us with not only an increase in the per-gallon water and sewer cost but also a delivery service fee. Since these cost increases were not expected, they were not incorporated into the budget. Future increases are likely as well. To help offset some of this increased cost, the CM Board of Directors has requested that the Long Range Planning Committee and its Resource Management and Conservation subcommittee investigate water usage in the resort and provide conservation recommendations for the Board's consideration. You can expect to receive email communications over the next few weeks containing facts and figures regarding our water use and cost, as well as water conservation suggestions and links to additional information on the internet. Please be sure the office has your current email address. Lastly, please remember that our *WaterSense* compliant toilet rebate program continues, giving you \$25 cash for each qualifying toilet replacement. The forms are available at the front desk.

Thank you for your conservation efforts. We can save a lot if we each do a little!




