PHYSICAL PHACTS

A resident politely asked me the other day how to maintain batteries in AZ. Heat is your worst enemy when it comes to batteries, and we have a plethora of

heat. My general opinion on batteries is approx. 2 yrs. Any time after that is just 'money in the bank' and a reason to cheer. Yes, they can most certainly last longer and sadly, at times, shorter, but in the end, with all the variables to consider, batteries just wear out.

Preventative maintenance is best practice when it comes to Golf Cart Batteries. Monthly the Carriage Manor Maintenance Team PM's their Golf Cart batteries. This requires multiple steps. Here are the steps I like to take: (1) Clean/ scrub terminals using baking soda and steel wire brush. (2) Check wires for tightness and damage. (3) Clean tops of batteries with a rag. A small amount of water can be used to get gunk off. More is not better in this case. (4) Open tops of batteries and check fluid level. When batteries are charged they bubble and release gas, water level does need to be

checked. I generally try to keep water about half inch above cells. (5) Wipe and inspect battery caps for damage and dirt. (6) Lastly, I like to blow battery compartment with a blower or compressed air. **Note, wear proper PPE when working on batteries. You are working around acid**

There are 100 different ways to PM batteries and probably their processes are all correct in some ways. The important thing to remember is to do it regularly. Any PM procedure is better than no PM procedure. You will learn, as you do it, what to look for and where TLC is needed so that you can get the most out of your batteries.

**For those on the Weed Program for January 2022 we averaged 18-20oz of chemical per Lot sprayed. Cheetah Pro and Hydro Cap were the chemicals used and SDS information is easily available on internet. If you have questions just ask. **



TRASH TALK

Have you been to the "Boutique" lately? If you haven't, or don't know what or where it is, you have been missing out on the CM free yard sale going on every day. Our "Boutique" is the platform and space adjacent to the end of the 40-yd roll-off trash dumpster located across from the fitness center. The old saying "One man's trash is another man's treasure" is no longer sexist, as many women now compete equally for the treasures to be found there. While a visit here adds a bit of excitement to many people's day and provides a no-cost way to reuse and repurpose a variety of items, the attending clutter often gets out of hand. Shopping the Boutique also benefits the community by reducing (if only slightly) our trash outflow.

Frequently adding to the clutter near, or in, the dumpster is the dropping off of large appliances, water heaters, and especially furniture, including recliners, couches, mattresses, tables, cabinets, and more. More than half of the large items end up in the dumpster, whether placed there by a resident, or by Maintenance. Maintenance clears the Boutique into the dumpster on Monday, Wednesday and Friday each week or when needed. Emptying the dumpster is not cheap! Each 40 -yd load costs approximately \$400, cost varying depending on weight plus fuel and other surcharges. This happens three, and sometimes, four times per week in the winter season. To put that in perspective, our cost to dispose of a recliner, mattress, box spring or a dryer or similar size item is about \$10. A couch is about \$20. Virtually all of us with a summer home know that the cost and logistics of disposing of these items back there is our individual responsibility. It should be here too, but we also know that doing so here in Mesa can be more difficult.

So, here's the deal: we will help you if you will help us.

YOU Please do not place any large furniture or appliances in the dumpster. Place all A/C units, appliances and water heaters (and other large metal items) on the pavement along the railing near the shed. Furniture items are more difficult to manage, as items that are worn, torn, stained, broken or full of pet hair are not acceptable to charitable organizations with resale shops. Typically, mattresses must be stain-free and less than 2-years old to be acceptable for donation. Nonetheless, please attempt to donate large items whenever possible. Please check the bulletin boards by the Patio and inside the clubhouse for a list of organizations to contact. If it's going to be hauled in a vehicle anyway, try to drop it off to them.

CM As needed, Maintenance will call a scrap dealer for pickup of the metal items at no cost to us. For now, furniture items left in the Boutique area will be placed in the dumpster by Maintenance at their discretion. This is to make best use of space in the dumpster and prevent overloading. Thank you for caring!
